These Rules are based on 32 Entries per division.

*64 Entries in either/both divisions will have sixteen (16) bowlers in the finals

*****Dress code for all rounds will be NO JEANS, AND NO HATS*****

2 Divisions: Those Born 1958 and before and those born 1959 and after

Only one Qualifying Round, 6:00 pm, Saturday, November 10, 2018. Check-in Begins at 5:00 pm. This Round will consist of four (4) games across eight (8) lanes. Entry Fee is \$80.00, (lineage \$14.00, expenses \$10.00, \$56.00 Prize fund). Final lineage will be paid from the Expense fund, and the prize fund returned at 100%. We will take the top 8 plus one alternate in each division.

Eight (8) bowlers will qualify for the Finals Round based on total pin fall during the qualifying round. When a tie exists for any position, a 9th and 10th frame shall be bowled and supervised by a tournament official immediately after the tie is discovered.

Finals Round: All Finalists and Alternates must check-in no later than 9:30 am. (Subject to change) Sunday, November 11, 2018, or they will be Disqualified and removed from the competition, no exceptions.

The finals round- This round is seeded by the qualifying round, (1 vs. 8), (4-5), (3-6), (2-7), This round shall be single elimination; total pins determines the winners. In case of a tie, a 9th and 10th frame shall be bowled, supervised by a tournament official. Bowlers losing the game will be out of the competition

Only one (1) alternate, the alternate in the finals shall be the next highest bowler from the qualifying round who is present. The alternate shall replace any bowler who does not appear or who is unable to start the competition. The alternate will assume the 8th seed position and every one else shall move up.

Payout will be one in four entries. Tournament will be paid out within 30 days after the end of the last day of the play.
